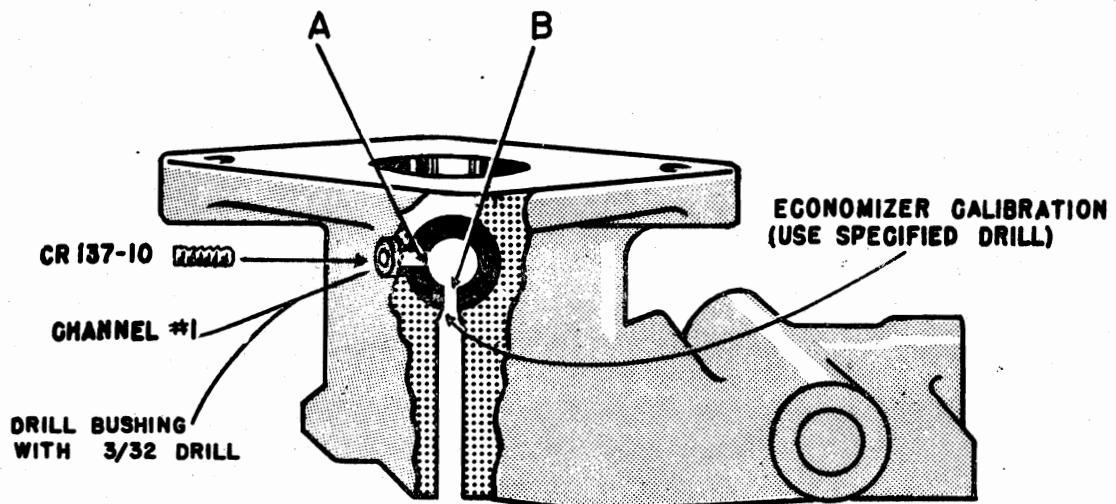

SUBJECT: ECONOMIZER CALIBRATION DRILL SIZE
for
"J" TYPE* 161 and 67 SERIES CARBURETORS



161J AND 67J MODELS

A review of the specifications for all "J" type 161 Series carburetors, supplied to date, indicates that in all but five cases the specified size for the Economizer Calibration is .055".

The five exceptions are: 10697, 10698, 10699, 10902 and 10903. The specified size for the Economizer Calibration for these carburetors is .071".

The above information applies to all "O" numbers up to and including 10913 and all "S" numbers up to and including S1585.

"S" numbers are no longer assigned to carburetor assemblies. Any future assemblies of "J" type 161 and 67 Series will bear regular assembly numbers above 10913. The specifications for the Economizer Calibration of these units will appear in Specification Bulletins, Form No. 534-1, and will be listed as "ECONOMIZER SIZE" with the drill size appearing as the decimal fraction of an inch in the proper column.

*The letter "J" appearing in the model designation indicates that the carburetor is equipped with Back Suction Economizer.
